Transitioning California to EERTUS

What is an ERTU?

Efficient rooftop units (ERTUs) are forced-air systems that package cooling, ventilation, and heating components into a single unit. ERTUs include design improvements to increase energy efficiency, as well as advanced control systems.





Key Barriers

- Limited product availability
- Minimal perceived benefit to manufacturers
- Ineffective product differentiation
- Nuanced installation techniques
- Concerns about cost and affordability

Strategic Interventions

- Research on equipment needs for CA climate
- Engage manufacturers on product
