# UTILITY ENERGY FORUM - 2022

Utilities have a growing obligation to meet regulations, mandates and requirements to transition to a clean energy future

SCPPA was formed 40+ years ago to allow Members to develop 1 transmission system and 2 large-scale generating stations, including the San Juan coal-fired power plant

SCPPA now has 31 renewable resource projects totaling 2,266 MW to serve Member communities

In addition to our Resource Development activities, SCPPA supports our Members with Program Development assistance, including:

- **Energy Efficiency/Demand Response**
- **Customer-owned solar and/or storage**
- **Electrification (Transportation and Building)**
